TERNA - PEOPLE AND CIRCULAR ECONOMY: VALUE GENERATION



Awarded by Terna S.p.A., this scholarship worth €8.000 is offered to one outstanding 2021/2022 Master in Environmental Sustainability & Circular Economy candidate. Candidates are chosen by an Evaluation Committee, composed solely of Terna S.p.A. personnel.

1. BENEFICIARIES AND REQUIREMENTS

In order to apply for this scholarship, candidates are asked to present the following documentation:

- > Application Form and CV/Resume;
- > Admission to the 2021 Master in Environmental Sustainability & Circular Economy;
- > Presentation video of a project or project idea on the theme of the Circular Economy which the student would like to implement.

2. SUBMISSION OF AND DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

Participants must send their application by e-mail to infomasters@mip.polimi.it, with subject line "TERNA - PEOPLE AND CIRCULAR ECONOMY 2021/22", by no later than 20th June, 2021. Only completed applications delivered by the due date will be submitted to Terna S.p.A

3. EVALUATION AND OUTCOME OF APPLICATION

Candidates will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- > Assessment of the video shared by the candidate based on the following requirements: content and the candidate's communication skills
- > Academic and professional record (CV/Resume)
- > Results of the Master in Environmental Sustainability & Circular Economy selection process

The successful candidate will be notified formally by MIP Admissions Office by letter no later than 9th July, 2021. The scholarship is awarded at the sole discretion of the Evaluation Committee, composed solely of Terna S.p.A. personnel, that will examine all the applications received which meet the requirements indicated and, whose decision is final and cannot be appealed against.

Several unsuccessful applicants may be placed on a waiting list and be reconsidered, at the discretion of the Committee, if the candidate who was awarded the scholarship withdraws his or her application.

4. INCOMPATIBILITY AND LOSS OF SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship can be combined with other scholarships, awards and/or financial support for specialisation courses offered by public or private bodies and/or companies, as long as the total amount does not exceed the total amount of the tuition fees. The beneficiary must self-certify that this total sum has not been exceeded. The beneficiary must comply with this condition for the whole duration of the Master in Environmental Sustainability & Circular Economy program.

In order to retain their rights to the scholarship, beneficiaries of a financial grant awarded on the basis of merit will be expected to maintain good academic performance throughout the Master in Environmental Sustainability & Circular Economy program, according to minimum standards set by the School.

The right to the scholarship is subject to the participant duly completing their 2021/22 Master in Environmental Sustainability & Circular Economy program.







5. ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS

By applying to this scholarship and accepting the ensuing award, candidates fully agree to the conditions contained herein. Under penalty of the immediate withdrawal of their scholarship, the successful candidate must confirm that they are enrolled on the Master in Environmental Sustainability & Circular Economy programme for 2021/22, as well as formally accepting all scholarship conditions by informing the Admissions Office within the deadline indicated in the letter confirming that he/she has been awarded the scholarship.
