# Accademia Teatro alla Scala Scholarship

For 2020/2022 MPAM candidates, Accademia offers 1 scholarship for Italian students only.

- 1 scholarship - 8.750 € (gross), to cover third and fourth installments

# Steps to apply

- 1. Apply to the Master in Performing Arts Management on www.applyformasters.net
- 2. Pass the admission interview to the Master's program by July 17, 2020.
- 3. Apply for the Accademia Teatro alla Scala scholarship no later than July 10, 2020 by sending an e-mail confirming your scholarship application to management@accademialascala.it with "MPAM Scholarship Accademia" written in the subject line.
- 4. Write an essay (the subject will be sent to you via email on July 10, 2020) and return it to management@accademialascala.it no later than July 17, 2020.
- 5. The successful candidate will be notified formally by the Committee via e-mail no later than July 24, 2020.

#### Criteria of admission

Candidates will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- academic and professional record
- results of the MPAM selection process (with a minimum score of 85/100)
- knowledge of English and Italian
- assessment of their written essay

Winners are chosen by a selected Committee representing the Program Direction.

The scholarship is awarded at the sole discretion of the Committee, whose decision is final and cannot be appealed against. Several unsuccessful applicants may be placed on a waiting list and be reconsidered, at the discretion of the Committee, if the candidate who was awarded the scholarship withdraws his or her application.

### Acceptance of the conditions

By applying to this scholarship and accepting the ensuing award, candidates fully agree to the conditions contained herein.

Under penalty of the immediate withdrawal of their scholarship, the successful candidate must confirm that they are enrolled on the MPAM program for 2020/2022, as well as formally accepting all scholarship conditions by informing the Admissions Office within the deadline indicated in the letter confirming that he/she has been awarded the scholarship.
