**GENERALI 4 GIRLS
IN STEM
SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded by GENERALI, this scholarship worth €10.000 (divided in two quota of €5.000 each) is offered to one outstanding 2021/2022 Master in Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship **woman** candidate. Candidates are chosen by a Generali selection Committee.

1. BENEFICIARIES AND REQUIREMENTS

In order to apply for this scholarship, women candidates are asked to present the following documentation:

- > Application Form;
- > Admission to the 2021 Master in Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship Programme;
- > Updated CV/resume;
- > Motivation letter.

2. SUBMISSION OF AND DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

Participants must send their application by e-mail to infomasters@mip.polimi.it, with subject line "GENERALI 4 GIRLS IN STEM SCHOLARSHIP 2021/22", by no later than **14th June, 2021**. Only completed applications delivered by the due date will be submitted to Generali.

3. EVALUATION AND OUTCOME OF APPLICATION

Candidates will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- > Academic and professional record (CV/resume)
- > Motivational interview
- > Results of the Master in Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship selection process

The successful candidate will be notified formally by MIP Admissions Office by letter no later than 5th July, 2021. The scholarship is awarded at the sole discretion of the Generali Committee, after the motivational interview, whose decision is final and cannot be appealed against.

Several unsuccessful applicants may be placed on a waiting list and be reconsidered, at the discretion of the Committee, if the candidate who was awarded the scholarship withdraws his or her application.

4. INCOMPATIBILITY AND LOSS OF SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship can be combined with other scholarships, awards and/or financial support for specialisation courses offered by public or private bodies and/or companies, as long as the total amount does not exceed the total amount of the tuition fees. The beneficiary must self-certify that this total sum has not been exceeded. The beneficiary must comply with this condition for the whole duration of the Master in Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship program.

In order to retain their rights to the scholarship, beneficiaries of a financial grant awarded on the basis of merit will be expected to maintain good academic performance throughout the Master in Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship program, according to minimum standards set by the School.

The right to the scholarship is subject to the participant duly completing their 2021/22 Master in Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship program.

5. ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS

By applying to this scholarship and accepting the ensuing award, candidates fully agree to the conditions contained herein. Under penalty of the immediate withdrawal of their scholarship, the successful candidate must confirm that they are enrolled on the Master in Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship programme for 2021/22, as well as formally accepting all scholarship conditions by informing the Admissions Office within the deadline indicated in the letter confirming that he/she has been awarded the scholarship.
