Grading scale: The Dutch grading scale runs from 1 to 10. The passing grades range from 6 (pass) to 10 (outstanding). 10 = outstanding (The grade 10 is hardly ever given); 9 = excellent; 8 = very good; 7 = satisfactory/good pass; 6 = pass/sufficient; 5-1 = fail. Sometimes no marks are given, but only the qualification PASS or FAIL.

Recommended for the following Polimi MSc Majors: AFB, BST, CPB, EM, FI, INN, INT, SCM, SSI.

ENT, only in the Spring semester. Undergraduate students are not allowed to enter graduate level courses. Some courses require prior knowledge, as indicated in the course description.

Language Proficiency Requirements: At FEB all exchange students need to submit an English proficiency test certificate. Test certificates must not be older than 2 years at the time of application. Please see here which English proficiency test certificates and test scores are accepted.
