Semester Exchange: 5 students for each AY

Level: BSc and MSc

**Academic Year:**

August/ September – December (Orientation is mandatory)

January – April/May (Orientation is mandatory)

**Grading scale:**

- a) For the Master Programme: Grading system: From 0 to 20, 20 being the best mark. Passing grade: 10 with a corresponding GPA out of 4.
- b) For the BBA (Bachelor) Programme: Grading system: US based. Grading scale from 0 to 4. Passing grade: C (2.0). Transcripts also show ECTS grades (A - E).

**Recommended for the following Polimi MSc Majors:** Skema BBA courses are all open to exchange students (all in English); For Master level courses students are required to choose specialization and follow its courses. Skema Master level courses are suitable for most Majors, but programs differ depending on location, so students must verify the different offerings. Analytics for Business, Circular Economy, Energy Management, industry 4.0 and Industrial Management Majors will find fewer options for their core requirements.

**Language Proficiency Requirements:** For exchange students the requirements are the following: TOEFL (550 ITP, 79 iBT), TOEIC 830, IELTS 6.5
