Thesis Summary	Research has identified many of the tiles composing the mosaic of partner selection, failing, in most cases, to satisfy the need for firms to utilize a more complete and systematic analysis in selecting partners, especially in the domain of Open Innovation and technological transfer. Therefore, the purpose of this study was to fill this gap, by developing a theoretical framework and an operational tool founded on the combination of the partner selection and proximity streams of literature. The Proximity-Based Selection Tool was created following the path beaten by Boschma (2005) and Hansen (2014). The experimental studies conducted demonstrated that:  1. the introduction of the dimensions of proximity, in the investigation of partner selection criteria, makes them interconnected components of the same system, rather than independent factors;  2. the notion of optimal proximity not only allows to understand which criteria should be satisfied for the success of the collaboration, but also to what extent; 3. a partner selection process strongly linked to characteristics and objective of the project favours the adoption of a more rigorous, detailed, and versatile approach.
