Thesis Summary	The thesis's purpose is to examine the impact of social capital on Open Innovation (OI) activities. The OI paradigm altered how firms achieve long-term competitiveness through a more collaborative approach. Academics have stressed the importance of relation among interested parties as a crucial component of OI, as innovation-related activities must rely on a firm's ties, to collect knowledge in external ecosystems. In this context, the notion of social capital might be extended to OI. The work intends to provide an understanding of the principles that innovators may use to exploit social capital for innovation projects and of the mechanisms by which social capital can affect innovation. In the thesis, an exploratory analysis is performed. Through the analysis the notion that social capital is intrinsically linked to Open Innovation practices is strengthened, and a model consisting of three phases (Building, Activating, Leveraging) aimed at deploying social capital is developed.

Thesis Summary	The thesis investigates two extremely relevant topics for current and future organisations, first through a bibliometric analysis and then through a critical analysis of the literature: Circular Economy, a new economic paradigm developed in a transversal manner with a perspective of Zero Waste, and Sustainable Innovation, a form of innovation aimed at reducing environmental impacts and making the circular economic model possible. Companies may acquire a spendable competitive edge with customers and a more sustainable style of consumption by implementing Sustainable Innovation, as well as adopting new production processes. These concepts are diametrically opposed to the previous model, the Linear Economy, which is now obsolete since it is founded on the erroneous notion that resources are infinite and that sustainability is a barrier to development and innovation.
